

PRIVACY POLICY

Lightfoot, Franklin & White LLC ("Lightfoot" or "We") understands your concerns about privacy and is committed to protecting your privacy through our compliance with this notice.

INFORMATION COLLECTION

We do not actively collect any information that identifies you personally, such as your name, address, telephone number or email address, other than a domain name and Internet Protocol (IP) address. The domain name and IP address reveals nothing personal about you other than the IP address from which you have accessed our site. We may also collect information about the type of Internet browser you are using, operating system, what brought you to our site, as well as which of our website's pages you have accessed.

We receive non-personal data through cookies, log files and third-party analytics when you access our site.

- Cookies are pieces of stored information on a user's computer or device that are tied to information about the
 user and used to provide smoother navigation throughout the site, such as to store a saved password; to
 identify user trends, such as page views; and for other internal purposes, such as to assess the effectiveness
 of the site. You have the option of setting your computer to disable cookies or to alert you when cookies are
 being used. If you choose to disable cookies, please be aware that portions of the site may not function
 properly.
- Log files store information such as a user's IP, browser type, Internet Service Provider (ISP), referring/exit pages, platform type, date/time stamp and number of clicks. Like most websites, the site uses log files to analyze trends, administer the site and track users' movement on the site in the aggregate.
- Third party analytics are provided by automated devices and applications, such as Google Analytics and Google Analytics Advertising Features, to evaluate the use of our services.
