Essig spoke to students about the importance of accounting in investigations. He provided the students with factual scenarios based on his broad experience conducting investigations as an Assistant U.S. Attorney, in the Marine Corps, and in a corporate environment.

His career also includes serving in the legal department of a major defense contractor.
