CHANDLER BAILEY AND HARLAN PRATER PARTICIPATE IN PLAC PANEL ON EFFECTS OF PANDEMIC ON FUTURE JURIES

Lightfoot, Franklin & White LLC partners **Chandler Bailey** and **Harlan Prater** participated in a panel discussion for the virtual **PLAC** 2020 Fall Conference. Bailey moderated the discussion, which focused on the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on future juries.

The panel examined how negative “baggage” from the pandemic could influence jurors’ thinking on particular issues, as well as whether the demographic makeup of juries may change if older citizens and those with pre-existing conditions opt out of service.
