The recognition was announced at a meeting of the organization's Women in the Law Committee on June 6 and an article about the Tribute will be featured in DRI's *For the Defense* magazine.

The Tribute honors Olson's years of service to DRI and her commitment to philanthropy and public service on behalf of the organization.
