LIGHTFOOT ATTORNEY ASHBY PATE SPEAKS (AND SINGS) AT ALABAMA STATE BAR ANNUAL MEETING

He also was a featured speaker at the 2016 American College of Trial Lawyers' spring meeting in Maui.
