## Firm raises \$5,516 to send 4-year-old boy undergoing chemo for brain tumor to Disney World

A four-year-old Alabama boy with a life-altering illness is receiving his wish to visit Disney World thanks to Lightfoot, Franklin & White LLC and **Magic Moments**. The firm partnered with the local wish-granting organization to raise money for the young boy who is undergoing chemotherapy for a brain tumor that has left him partially deaf.
