LIGHTFOOT SECURES SUMMARY JUDGMENT IN PRODUCT LIABILITY CASE

Lightfoot, Franklin & White LLC partners **Chandler Bailey** and **Jared Levinthal**, along with associate **Rachelle Sanchez**, obtained summary judgment on behalf of a major vehicle manufacturer client in a complex wrongful death and catastrophic injury case in Oklahoma.

The plaintiffs alleged claims of defective design arising from an automobile accident that occurred involving five federal agents in a 2013 full-size van. Their lawsuit claimed the van was defective and dangerous because it did not come equipped with forward collision alert and/or automatic emergency braking. Lightfoot's lawyers presented evidence that the vehicle was safe as designed and manufactured. The court agreed and held that the vehicle was not dangerous or defective as a matter of law.
