LIGHTFOOT'S TERRY MCCARTHY NAMED 2018 'FRIEND OF CUMBERLAND SCHOOL OF LAW'

BIRMINGHAM, Ala. (September 14, 2018) — Lightfoot, Franklin & White LLC partner **Terry McCarthy** has been named the 2018 'Friend of Cumberland School of Law' at Samford University.

He also serves on the Alabama Supreme Court Advisory Committee to the Alabama Rules of Evidence. Prior to attending law school, McCarthy worked as a university administrator, obtaining master's and doctorate degrees of education.
