LIZ HUNTLEY DELIVERS COMMENCEMENT ADDRESS FOR 2022 UNIVERSITY OF ALABAMA SCHOOL OF LAW GRADUATES

Lightfoot Senior Counsel and Director of Community Relations and Engagement Liz Huntley delivered the commencement address at the University of Alabama School of Law's 2022 graduation ceremony on May 8th.

This year's commencement holds special importance as it marks the 50th anniversary of the graduation of the first African American students from the School of Law. Those students, Michael Figures, Booker Forte Jr., and Ronald E. Jackson, were honored along with Alabama civil justice giant, Mr. Fred Gray, who received the Honorary Doctor of Laws Degree.
