LIZ HUNTLEY NAMED 'CITIZEN OF THE YEAR' BY WOMEN'S COMMITTEE OF 100 FOR BIRMINGHAM

BIRMINGHAM, Ala. (April 18, 2018) — Lightfoot of counsel **Liz Huntley** has received the "Citizen of the Year" award for 2018 from the Women's Committee of 100 for Birmingham. She was given the honor during the organization's awards luncheon on April 17.

Each year, the Women's Committee of 100 for Birmingham recognizes an individual for their "outstanding contributions to the people of the Birmingham metro area." The organization's selection committee looks for "someone with humanitarian qualities who has made an impact on the lives of others; a leader with commitment to improving the quality of life in Birmingham."
